Pre-Writing	<p>Crossing the Midline Activity: Sweeping the floor. This is an excellent activity for crossing midline, not to mention another great practical life skill.</p>	<p>Provide your child with a piece of mail, newspaper, or magazine. Have them look for the letters in their name.</p>	<p>Toddler Dot to Dot</p> 	<p>Name Letter Tracing - Write your child's name and have them trace the letters with their finger or trace with a crayon/marker.</p>	<p>Q-Tip Painting Activity: Draw patterns on a piece of paper and let your toddler paint the pattern with a Q-Tip. Any type of paint can be used for this activity. Toddlers can free paint with Q-Tips as well.</p>
Math	<p>Check out this interactive video on Measuring and Comparing: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=VIQg8e0erEE</p> <p>Compare and Contrast the objects that you chose to complete the activity. Use words such as: longer, bigger, taller, lighter, shorter, smaller and heavier to describe objects. Have children hold the objects and determine which is heavier or lighter than the others.</p>	<p>Counting Rays of the Sun Activity https://drive.google.com/file/d/1YtFfYlto2VUrZHVzzhAE0S9Qh4UawPUz/view</p>	<p>Shape Sorting - Look for objects around your house that are different shapes: circles, squares, or triangles.</p> 	<p>While exploring your sensory bin, find all the similar objects and put them together (Ex. Can you find all the pinecones? Let's put all the rocks in a pile.) Once they are categorized, count how many you have (We have 3 flowers! You found 1 pinecone.)</p>	<p>Draw one shape on a piece of paper and place stickers on the outline of the shape. If you do not have stickers, any smaller object can be placed on the outline of the shape.</p> 

<p>Science/ Social Studies</p>	<p>Wind Activity Provide a variety of objects (straw, twigs, wooden blocks, ping pong balls, Lego blocks, leaves, different sized rocks, paper, balloons, etc.). Let children use their breath or a straw to blow and try moving the objects around the table without touching them. Children will discover which objects they can move and which they can't. Help children to record their findings. 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<p>Art</p>	<p>Kites (Print or Copy Kite template: http://www.nuttinbutpreschool.com/kite-pattern-coloring/)</p> <p>Cut diamond shapes out of cardboard. Let each child draw on one shape. When they are done, transform the diamonds to represent kites, adding a long tail and bows. Hang the kites from the ceiling, within your home.</p>	<p>Materials needed: paper plates; hole puncher; string, markers</p> <p>In advance: Cut the paper plates in half. Then cut off the rims of the paper plates halves. Hole punch each side of the paper plate rims.</p> <p>Child decorates the rims. For this activity, you can use real or fake flowers. Place a small amount of paint on a paper plate. Encourage the child to dip their flower into the paint and use it as a paintbrush! Ask the child what he/she is painting, what colors they are using, etc.</p>	<p>Earth Painting: Place blue and green paint on a paper plate. Put the paper plate in a large ziplock bag and begin painting.</p>

See how many they can get it and then stand further away each time.</p> 	<p>Go on a walk and explore the environment.
