

COVID-19 PANDEMIC DISCLOSURE AND SCREENING TOOL



Parents play a crucial role in keeping children, families and staff safe and reducing the risk of exposure. Prior to your home visit or attending an activity, please check your child for the following:

GROUP A 1 OR MORE SYMPTOMS	GROUP B 2 OR MORE SYMPTOMS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fever of 100 degrees or more • New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing • Children with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough: a change in their baseline cough • Lack of smell or taste • Shortness of breath 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sore throat • Muscle aches • Headache • Congestion or runny nose • Nausea/vomiting • Extreme fatigue • Frequent diarrhea • Chills

While we understand that many of these symptoms can also be related to non-COVID-19 related issues, we must proceed with an abundance of caution during this Pandemic.

Please contact your Home Visitor if:

- Has one or more symptoms in Group A, **OR**
- Has two or more symptoms in Group B, **OR**
- Is awaiting COVID-19 test results or a household member is awaiting COVID-19 test results.

Can return to home visits:

- If fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication such as Acetaminophen (Tylenol) or Ibuprofen (Motrin).
- If symptoms are improving.
- If examined by a physician and medical documentation is provided (a Doctor’s note).
- Fulfilled your quarantine time frame.

When in doubt, we recommend checking with your health care provider.

Positive COVID-19 Test

- Please notify your Home Visitor if your child has a positive COVID-19 test.
- If your child or a household member tests positive for COVID-19, it will be 10 days before a visit can occur and there will be an option for virtual home visits.

Mask Wearing at Home Visits and Activities

- Indoor masking for staff, parents, and children (ages two and older) is required only when community levels are high.
- Masks are not worn during meal times, naps, or outdoor play.
- A medical exemption note will be required for children that cannot wear a mask (during high community levels) due to medical conditions/disabilities.
