

COVID-19 PANDEMIC DISCLOSURE AND SCREENING TOOL



Parents play a crucial role in keeping everyone in the facility safe and reducing the risk of exposure. Prior to attending class, please check your child for the following:

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fever of 100 degrees or more• New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing• Children with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough: a change in their baseline cough• Lack of smell or taste• Shortness of breath	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sore throat• Muscle aches• Headache• Congestion or runny nose• Nausea/vomiting• Extreme fatigue• Frequent diarrhea• Chills
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While we understand that many of these symptoms can also be related to non-COVID-19 related issues, we must proceed with an abundance of caution during this Pandemic.

Please keep your child home if he or she:

- Has 2 or more symptoms from the above list.
 - * If exposure to COVID-19 has occurred, your child may remain in class as long as they do not have symptoms.

Can return to class:

- If fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication such as Acetaminophen (Tylenol) or Ibuprofen (Motrin).
- If symptoms are improving.
- If examined by a physician and medical documentation is provided (a Doctor's note) with return date.

When in doubt, we recommend checking with your health care provider.

Positive COVID-19 Test

- If your child tests positive for COVID-19, they need to quarantine for at least 5 days. They may return to the center/classroom if they are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication and if symptoms have improved. Upon return, in accordance with CDC guidelines, it is recommended that your child wear a mask from days 6 - 10 if age two or above.
- Please notify someone at your center/classroom or the nurse for your county if your child has a positive COVID-19 test.
